

# **OAFC Summer Select**

## **Summer Intern Program - 2026**



**Who:** The program is open to college students with an interest in a healthcare career track.

**What:** 8-week summer volunteer internship (unpaid) at Open Arms Free Clinic

**Where:** You will work within Walworth County - at OAFC, with our Mobile Medical Clinic and at outreach sites throughout the community.

**Why:** This internship will give you a look at healthcare access needs in our county. It will expose you to a different perspective than one you might be used to, helping to round out your understanding of how people access healthcare. You will gain experience and insight that can inform your decision-making, as you think about your future and career path. You will also have the opportunity for patient care, connections with healthcare practitioners, and networking.

**When:** 8-week program, from mid-June to the beginning of August (with a flex week surrounding the 4th of July holiday). Orientation will be held on May 27, 2026. You will be asked to attend our Golf Outing on June 2nd and the clinical program will begin on June 8th. Applications due by April 15th, interviews and selection to follow. Interviews can be conducted in person or over Zoom. Final selections will be made by May 15th.

*Minimum* commitment of 10 hours per week. Must be available on Mondays and strongly preferred to be available on Tuesdays. Clinical hours will be available Mon-Thur only.

*\*There may be some opportunity for flexibility, determined on a case-by-case basis. The minimum commitment will be ten (10) hours per week, with the option to expand those hours if desired.*

### **Brief:**

During this 8-week internship program, students will participate in a variety of OAFC activities, including but not limited to days at the medical clinic, dental clinic and work on advancing our behavioral health initiatives. A large focus will be to work with our Outreach Program Manager in supporting the Mobile Medical Clinic, which travels to locations throughout Walworth County as well as participating in outreach events throughout the community as a representative of OAFC. Additional learning opportunities include bi-monthly trainings with clinic providers and external partners in a variety of disciplines.

### **Core Objectives:**

- Learn Community Health & Wellness Needs
- Observe the interdisciplinary care team
- Implement & Help Execute at least one health promotion activity

### **Deliverable:**

End of season reflection and presentation of QI Projects, to be presented to the OAFC team.
