### **Internship Summary:**

We seek a passionate, motivated and community-focused pharmacy intern to join our team for the summer. This role offers a unique opportunity to work in a non-profit healthcare setting, where you will gain hands-on clinical and operational pharmacy experience while making a meaningful impact on the lives of patients who depend on our services.

### **During this internship, students may:**

- Assist with medication dispensing under pharmacist supervision
- Provide patient medication counseling
- Participate in medication adherence reviews
- Provide disease state education to patients
- Gain exposure to pharmacy practice in a nonprofit clinic setting

### **Key Responsibilities\*:**

- Support pharmacy operations by assisting the pharmacist in preparing prescriptions.
- Ensure the accuracy of processed prescriptions including medication, dose and directions.
- Differentiate between a registered pharmacy and a dispensary, as defined under WI state law.
- Maintain inventory management by stocking shelves, monitoring stock levels, ordering/receiving medications and checking for expired medications.
- Assist with medication access programs including patient assistance programs and WI Drug Repository Program.
- Assist the pharmacist with tasks to improve workflow and efficiency.
- Shadow the pharmacist during patient consultations to learn best practices.
- Observe the pharmacist collaborate with the care team to optimize patient care including medication therapy management and chronic disease state monitoring.
- Help maintain and update patient records using electronic health records (EHR).
- Complete one capacity-building and sustainability project
