

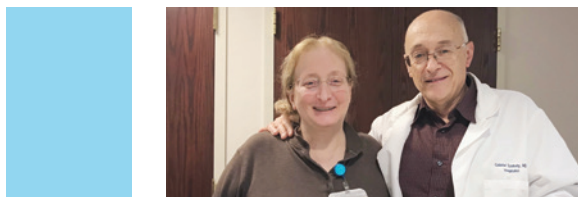
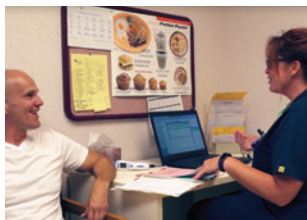


WHY A FREE CLINIC?

This note from Brigitte is an example of one of over 8,000 people in Walworth County who find themselves without insurance or the resources to pay for medical care. For those without the ability to pay, the Open Arms Free Clinic is the only clinic of its kind in Walworth County, exclusively dedicated to providing primary medical and dental care to all of its qualifying patients, as well as ongoing care and navigation for those with chronic disease - all without charge.

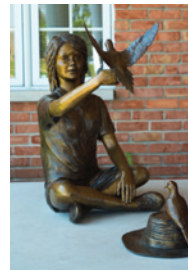

Medical exams, medication for acute and chronic illness, laboratory and diagnostic services, and referral to specialty care
